### Last Call for Editor in Chief of Biology of Reproduction



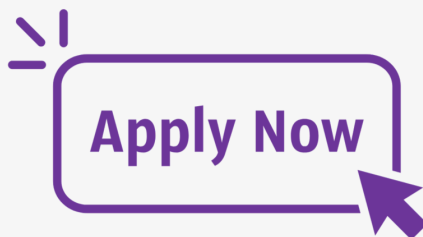
