

WHO WE ARE

The Society was founded 51 years ago and now is a global association of scientists, veterinarians, and physicians from more than 50 countries. Some members are engaged in basic or applied research, while others perform clinical practice. All are dedicated to advancing knowledge of reproductive processes in animals and in humans. Members are affiliated with colleges and universities, medical and veterinary schools, medical centers, research institutes, government agencies, and industry. SSR members have made key contributions in stem cell biology, transgenesis, treatment of infertility, contraception, livestock production, pregnancy health, treatment of reproductive system cancers, and identification of environmental contaminants. SSR members are internationally recognized. They include members of the U.S. National Academy of Sciences and recipients of the Lasker Award, the Wolf Prize, the Grand Prix Charles-Leopold Mayer, and the International Prize for Biology.
